Prof. Mohiyuddin Nedukandiyil Karassery was the head of the department of Malayalam and Kerala Studies in Calicut University (2010–2012). He published many books and articles on Malayalam language and Kerala culture. As an expert of Arabic Malayalam, the 'Urdu' of Kerala Muslims, he was hosted in June in the Freie Universität Berlin for a workshop on Arabic Malayalam. Invited to Germany by the Ruhr-Universität Bochum for participating in a workshop on *Islamic Performance Traditions across Regions between West and Southeast Asia* he visits now Tübingen and its Gundert-Chair.
