"From subsistence to wealth: economy in the Copper Age settlement of Valencina de la Concepción (Andalusia, Spain)"

Prof. Leonardo García Sanjuán Universidad de Sevilla, Spain

In this talk will be the state of our knowledge concerning the economy of Copper Age societies in southern Spain reviewed. Given the amplitude of this subject, Prof. Sanjuán will focus on the site of Valencina de la Concepción (Sevilla) as a case-study that helps us understand the diversity and complexity of the economic system that unfolded in 3rd millennium Iberia.

This will include a discussion of the available evidence to understand the subsistence production. husbandry, including animal agriculture and hunting, as well as the exploitation of abiotic resources, including siliceous rocks, copper and exotic materials imported from other regions of the Iberian peninsula and abroad. The state of our knowledge on these topics, pointing out the main current problems and potential future lines of research will be summarised.
