Well public transport accessible towns around Tübingen

Dear student,

The housing market in Tübingen is very difficult, especially for the many students who have not been able to get a place in a hall of residence.

It is an acceptable option not to live in Tübingen itself, but in a district outside the city or a village/town in the surrounding area.

Advantages are lower rent and less competition when looking for a room or small flat.

Disadvantages are the time it takes to commute to Tübingen.

When checking public transportation for a location, please do not use Google Maps. Some connections are not included there, so you will be shown a connection that is much too long or no connection at all.

You can only get reliable information on public transport connections in the region around Tübingen from Naldo - the local transport association. We recommend using the app, but there is also an option via the web browser.

To make your search outside of Tübingen easier, we have compiled a list of towns that are no more than 30 minutes away from Tübingen's main train station by public transport.

The times for the last connection all refer to weekday connections. Most of them have additional nighttime connections on the nights of Fri/Sat and Sat/Sun up or even on weekdays until 2 or 3 am. The timetables usually are updated once or twice a year and there might be some short-term changes due to construction sites and similar issues, so these times might not be exact. But despite these changes, the last connection will most likely still be between 11 pm and midnight.

Travel time in each case from the station in the town to the main station in Tübingen.

Well public transport accessible towns around Tübingen less than 30 minutes away:

Reutlingen (8-16 min by train, many connections, last 23:46)

Kirchentellingsfurt (6 min by train, half-hourly connections, last at 23:46)

Hirschau (7 min by bus, half-hourly to quarter-hourly connections, last at 23:36)*

Wurmlingen (12 min by bus, half-hourly connection, last at 23:36)*

Rottenburg (9 min by train/ 24 min by bus, half-hourly connection, last at 23:33/23:36)

Weilheim (7 min by bus, half-hourly to quarter-hourly connections, last at 23:29)

Kilchberg (11 min by bus, half-hourly to quarter-hourly connection, last at 23:29)*

Bühl (15 min by bus, half-hourly to quarter-hourly connection, last at 23:29)

Dusslingen (8 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 23:33)

Nehren (12-14 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 23:33)

Mössingen (11-18 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 23:33)

Bodelshausen (24 min by train, half-hourly to hourly connection, last at 23:33)

Hechingen (18-31 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 23:33)

Unterjesingen (8-15 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 00:32)*

Pfäffingen (10-12 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 00:20)

Entringen (13-16 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 00:20)

Altingen (17 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 00:20)

Gültstein (20 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 00:20)

Herrenberg (26 min by train, half-hourly connection, last at 00:20) Tübingen-Herrenberg connection ("Ammertalbahn", other stops: Unterjesingen, Pfäffingen, Entringen, Altingen, Gültstein): Train is often replaced by buses, which take a little longer, but also half-hourly connection.

Neustetten Remmingheim (23-31 min, half-hourly connection, last train at 23:33 or 02:00)

Neustetten Nellingsheim (25-30 min, half-hourly connection, last train at 23:33 or 02:00)

Kusterdingen (10 min by bus, half-hourly to quarter-hourly connection, the last one at 00:30 from the stop "Finanzamt Tübingen". This stop is on the "back side" of the station, you can find it with Google Maps)

Wankheim (11 min by bus, half-hourly to quarter-hourly connection, last at 00:35)*

Mähringen (26-29 min by bus, half-hourly to quarter-hourly connection, last at 00:35)*

Bebenhausen (12 min by bus, quarter-hourly connection, last at 23:55)*

Dettenhausen (25 min by bus, every 20 minutes, last bus at 23:55)

[*no supermarket in town, but in the next town, easily accessible by bus/train].
